

USA Swimming

The Auburn YMCA Stingrays program offers two sessions of USA swimming.

**Session 1 runs during the YMCA season from September through March
Cost: \$100**

**Session 2 runs from April through August replacing the Stingrays previous
spring and summer sessions. Cost: \$200**

**The registration fees cover the USA swimmer registration, LSC fees and
additional coaches expenses.**

**Session 1 will include six USA competitions on Saturdays and/or Sunday.
These meets will not interfere with our Scheduled YMCA meets.**

**Session 2 will include two to three competitions a month from May through
August.**

Transportation is not provided to USA competitions

**USA meets run similar to YMCA invitationals and championship meets. There
is a fee per event for each swimmer. i.e. \$3 per event and \$3 deck fee.**

USA Swimming Q/A's

How much does it cost to register my Stingray for USA swimming?

Session 1 runs September through March and cost \$100

Session 2 will run April-August and cost \$200

*July and August practice will be held at Casey Park

Who should sign up for USA swimming?

Generally swimmers who are looking for additional competition whether during the YMCA season or during the spring and summer.

How will my kid benefit from USA competition?

In recent years some of our more advanced swimmers have not been tested by their competition until Y-States. USA meets will expose them to levels of competition that they do not typically face during the YMCA dual meet season.

Can I sign up for just USA swimming and not YMCA swimming?

No. You must be on the **Auburn YMCA Stingrays** to swim USA swimming for our team.

It's my child's first season on the Stingrays. Should I sign them up for USA swimming?

It might be a good idea to just do YMCA swimming the first season. If they enjoy the YMCA season it might be something to look into in the future.

Who will be the USA swimming coaches for the Stingrays?

If I sign my kid up for USA swimming does this mean they have to attend every meet on the schedule?

No. Swimmers may swim in as many or as few USA meets as they wish. However, the meets they do swim in must be on our Stingray schedule.
